## UNIE's commitment to Sustainable Development and the environment.

UNIE recognizes its pivotal role as a higher education institution in advancing the United Nations Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). With a strong commitment to the environment and society, UNIE has established the following foundational principles that guide all its activities, including the Erasmus+ Program:

- 1. To design and implement training programs that provide knowledge and skills to students to undertake and address the SDGs
- 2. Develop mechanisms to train and incentivize students and faculty to enhance research on sustainable development.
- 3. Guarantee compliance with the legal provisions that affect it in environmental matters and other requirements to which the University subscribes, maintaining a relationship of dialogue and collaboration with the competent environmental organizations and interest groups in its social environment.
- 4. To prevent, reduce and eliminate, whenever possible, the negative environmental impact that may arise from its teaching, research and associated services.
- 5. To promote an increasing level of efficiency in the use of natural and energy resources.
- 6. To promote recycling, recovery and reuse of materials, as well as the reduction of waste.
- 7. To manage the consumption of water, paper and electricity with ecological and saving criteria.
- 8. To update this environmental policy in accordance with new environmental requirements and the progress achieved under a permanent approach of continuous improvement.
- 9. Publicize and promote its environmental policy for awareness and adherence. As part of its commitment, the University takes necessary steps to inform, educate, and raise awareness among all personnel to uphold the guidelines outlined in this environmental policy and comply with current environmental regulations in their roles.
