Contents	The Final Degree Project consists of the preparation, presentation and defence of an original piece of work through which the basic and specific competences associated with the Bachelor Degree in Psychology are assessed. The work will be carried out individually and will be supervised by a lecturer responsible for guiding and supervising each student. The design and preparation of the FDP must be based on theoretical foundations and the integration of information based on empirical evidence. It will consist of a review paper or experimental research, preferably in accordance with one of the specialisations of the proposed degree: • Specialisation in Clinical Psychology. • Specialisation in Psychosocial Intervention • Specialisation in Psychological Assessment and Intervention. The assessment parameters, as well as the lines of work, will be detailed in the subject teaching guide. This work will be assessed in a public defence by a panel of experts in the field.
